Payment	The cost of this trip is £11. Please pay via Scopay by Friday 10th May .
Clothing	Children should wear smart school uniforms, including their Hordle jumpers (no hoodies) and black shoes/trainers.
Equipment	Children should bring a SMALL day bag filled with their lunch and a water bottle only.
Lunch/Dinner arrangements	Children will need to bring a packed lunch in as small a container as possible. We will be eating outside in the cathedral grounds or inside the cathedral. If your child is in receipt of <u>Free School Meals</u> and would like a lunch provided by the school, please order your child's lunch <u>here</u> .
Consent	The 'Blanket Trip Consent' covers this trip, you will need to let the school know IN WRITING that your child will NOT be attending by Friday 10th May 2024
Medical Declaration	Your child's current medical status will be used on the day. If there are any other conditions about which the school is not aware, and that you believe may impact on their ability to take part in this event, please inform the group leader /school office prior to the activity.
