When designing learning at Hordle C.E. Primary School, we make sure that children are stimulated by challenging learning opportunities. However, in order to learn how to successfully tackle challenge both within the classroom and beyond, learn how pupils need to persevere. Therefore, we use the language of resilience within school, reminding children to 'never give up' and 'to keep trying'. Pupils are also taught to approach challenge with an open mind, considering other ways to overcome difficulties, such as adapting their approach or trying something they haven't considered before. By teaching the skills of resilience, pupils learn to approach with enthusiasm challenge and optimism, a skill for life.


